The abstract was poorly presented. A good abstract should be focused on the problem statement, research methodology, findings, and implications. No definition should be in the abstract.
The introduction should include the issues to be addressed (the problem statement). It should also address the theoretical gap before the practical issue. Do SMEs understand the sustainability report? How does it impact their performance?
Why were the three elements of performance chosen? No explanation was provided; thus, the discussion was raw and lacked robustness. Hypotheses were developed without adequate elaboration, leading to most of them not
